GOVERNMENT OF TAMILNADU Emergency Response services

Memorandum of Understanding between Government of Tamil Nadu (GOTN) and Emergency Management and Research Institute (EMRI).

Preamble

Public Private Partnership (PPP) in the context of the health sector is an effective instrument for improving the health care facilities in general and pre-hospital care based emergency response services in particular.

Emergency Management Research Institute for utilization as earlier mentioned. Purchase of such ambulances shall be in accordance with the specifications provided by EMRI. Government may also entrust purchase of ambulances according to required specifications to EMRI.

- (d) Initially, premises at the Health Visitors Training School, Triplicane for a temporary Emergency Response Centre shall be handed over to EMRI for suitable renovation/ modification to enable functioning at an early date. On moving to the permanent premises, Health Visitors Training School shall be returned to the Health department.
- (e) To establish a permanent Emergency Response Center, training centre and office premises, suitable land will be provided by the Government for which the infrastructure would be developed by EMRI in consultation with TNHSP. All infrastructures with equipments so created shall be the property of the Government of Tamil Nadu.
- (f) TNHSP on behalf of Government of Tamli Nadu shall provide all lialson assistance for Primary Health Centers, Community Health Centers, Private hospitals, District Hospitals and Teaching Hospitals and other Specialty Hospitals in the state that are run by the Government and the private sector in order to facilitate appropriate medical treatment for patients requiring Emergency Medical care.
- (g) Establish or approve various training programs including necessary facilities required for efficient emergency response (such as paramedical, courses, continuing education programmes for doctors, first responder programmes, simulation lab, etc.)



- (iv) Clause 2(t) shall be omitted.
- (2) That, as varied and amended as aforesaid, the Principal MOU shall remain in full force and effect and fully binding upon the parties hereto.
