WARNINGS FOR FISHERMEN

The Depression over eastcentral & adjoining northeast Bay of Bengal moved westnorthwest direction with a speed of 14 kmph in last 6 hours and lay centered at 2330 hrs IST of 24th September 2021, over northeast and adjoining east-central Bay of Bengal near Lat. 18.4°N and Long. 90.4°E, about 580 km east-southeast of Gopalpur (Odisha) & 660 km east of Kalingapatnam (Andhra Pradesh).

COAST	WIND WARNINGS
Tamil Nadu & Puducherry	Day 1(25.09.2021) to Day 2(26.09.2021): Strong wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over southwest & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal and Comorin area. Day 3(27.09.2021) & Day 4(28.09.2021): Strong wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area and southwest Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the period mentioned above.
Other than Tamil Nadu	Day 3(27.09.2021) & Day 4(28.09.2021): Strong wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Lakshadweep & southeast Arabian Sea, Kerala and Maldives. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the period mentioned above. Day 1(25.09.2021): Squally weather with wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph very likely over Northwest and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal and increase gradually becoming gale wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph from the evening and 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph from 26th morning till evening. The fishermen are advised not to venture into east-central & adjoining northeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea on 25th Sept. Day 1(25.09.2021) & Day 2(26.09.2021): Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely along and off OdishaNorth Andhra Pradesh coasts from 25th morning. It will gradually increase becoming gale wind speed reaching 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph from afternoon of 26th till midnight along & off north Andhra Pradesh & adjoining south Odisha coasts. The fishermen are advised not to venture into northwest & adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off Odisha, West Bengal & North Andhra Pradesh coasts till 27th Sept.

HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

<u>ANDAMAN:</u> High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.6 meters are forecasted during 20:30 hours on 24-09-2021 to 23:30 hours of 27-09-2021 along the west coast of Andaman Islands between Ten Degree Channel to Coco Channel. Current speeds vary between 52 - 76 cm/sec.

<u>ANDHRA PRADESH</u>: High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.6 meters are forecasted during 20:30 hours on 24-09-2021 to 23:30 hours of 26-09-2021 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh from Visakhapatnam to Baruva. Surface Current speeds vary between 101 - 152 cm/sec.

<u>ODISHA:</u> High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.7 meters are forecasted during 20:30 hours on 24-09-2021 to 23:30 hours of 26-09-2021 along the coast of Odisha from Gopalpur to Chandipur.

<u>WEST BENGAL:</u> High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.9 meters are forecasted during 20:30 hours on 24-09-2021 to 23:30 hours of 26-09-2021 along the coast of West Bengal from Digha to Bakkhali.

<u>NICOBAR:</u> High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.7 meters are forecasted during 20:30 hours on 24-09-2021 to 23:30 hours of 27-09-2021 along the west coast of Nicobar Islands from Ten Degree Channel to Great Channel. Surface Current speeds vary between 40-70cm/sec.
