Day 1(15.07.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Gulf of Mannar, Tamilnadu coast and Southwest Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.

HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

Karnataka: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.8 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 17-07-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 43 - 54 cm/sec.
Lakshadweep: High swell waves in the range of 3.2 - 3.6 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 16-07-2022 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 46 - 60 cm/sec.

Kerala: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.2 meters are forecasted till 2330 hours of 17-07-2022 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod. Current speeds vary between 53 - 61 cm/sec.
