Sub: Special message regarding maximum temperatures over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal

### Maximum temperatures observed during the past 24 hours:

During the 24-hr ending 08:30 IST of today (**06.05.2024**), the maximum temperatures over Tamilnadu were generally **above normal to appreciably above normal** over many places in the plains of interior Tamilnadu, **markedly above normal** at isolated pockets in north interior Tamilnadu and **normal to above normal** over the coastal areas of Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal. **Heatwave condition** prevailed at a few pockets in north interior Tamilnadu.

Highest maximum temperature recorded at Karur Paramathi43.8°C (+7.5°C) followed by Erode: 43.4°C(+5.9°C), Tirupattur: 42.2°C(+5.0°C), Vellore: 42.1°C(+3.1°C), Madurai\_AP: 41.8°C(+4.2°C), Tiruchirappalli\_AP: 41.7°C (+3.6°C), Tiruthani: 41.7°C(+1.8°C), Salem: 41.0°C (+3.8°C) and Palayamkottai: 41.0°C (+3.6°C).

Plains of the rest of Interior Tamilnadu recorded 38-40°C. The coastal areas of Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal recorded 36°C to 38°C and the hilly areas, 24°C to 26°C temperatures.

Chennai recorded normal maximum (MBK:39.4°C, +1.8°C and NBK: 37.0°C, +0.6°C).





(06.05.2024 to 10.05.2024). Relative Humidity (06.05.2024 - 10.05.2024):</b> Humidity is likely to be about 30-50% in the afternoon hours and 45-80% during the rest of the day over the plains of interior districts; and 55-85% over the coastal areas during the next five days (06.05.2024 to 10.05.2024).
Warning Day-1 (06.05.2024)	Heat wave conditions are likely to prevail at isolated pockets over North Interior Tamilnadu.
Warning Day-2 (07.05.2024)	Heat wave conditions are likely to prevail at isolated pockets over Interior Tamilnadu.
Warning Day-1 to Day-3 (06.05.2024- 08.05.2024)	Due to humid air & high temperatures, hot & discomfort weather is very likely to prevail at isolated pockets over rest of Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area

### ADVISE FOR MINIMISING IMPACTS DUE TO HEAT STRESS

- Avoid going out in the sun, especially between 12.00 noon and 3.00 p.m.
- Drink sufficient water and as often as possible, even if not thirsty
- Wear lightweight, light-coloured, loose and porous cotton clothes. Use protective goggles, umbrella/hat, shoes or chappals while going out in sun.
- Avoid strenuous activities when the outside temperature is high. Avoid working outside between 12 noon and 3 p.m.
- While travelling, carry water with you.
- If you work outside, use a hat or an umbrella and also use a damp cloth on your head, neck, face and limbs.
- Do not leave children or pets in parked vehicles.
- If you feel faint or ill, see a doctor immediately.
- Use ORS, homemade drinks like lassi, torani (rice water), lemon water, buttermilk, etc. which helps to re-hydrate the body.
- Keep animals in shade and give them plenty of water to drink.
- Keep your home cool, use curtains, shutters or sunshade and open windows at night.
- Use fans, damp clothing and take bath in cold water frequently.

#### TIPS FOR TREATMENT OF A PERSON AFFECTED BY A SUNSTROKE

- Lay the person in a cool place, under a shade. Wipe her/him with a wet cloth/wash the body frequently. Pour normal temperature water on the head. The main thing is to bring down the body temperature.
- Give the person ORS to drink or lemon sarbat/torani or whatever is useful to rehydrate the body.
- Take the person immediately to the nearest health centre. The patient needs immediate hospitalisation, as heat strokes could be fatal.

#### **ACCLIMATISATION**

People at risk are those who have come from a cooler climate to a hot climate. You may have such a person(s) visiting your family during the heat wave season. They should not move about in open field for a period of one week till the body is acclimatized to heat and should drink plenty of water. Acclimatization is achieved by gradual exposure to the hot environment during heat wave.
