Realised	Recurrent moderate rainfall activity at many places with isolated heavy to very heavy rain		
Rainfall	occurred over the coastal and adjoining districts of Tamil Nadu; Puducherry and Karaika during the past11 days.




Fig.1 Cumulative rainfall during the past 11 days








Fig.2 Rainfall during the 24-hr period from 08:30 IST of 08.11.21 to 08:30 IST of 09.11.21
