DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(10.07.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar, south Tamilnadu coast & adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.
Day 2(11.07.2022) to Day 4(13.07.2022)	Nil

DAY	FOR OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(10.07.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Andhra Pradesh coast and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.
Day 2(11.07.2022) to Day 4(13.07.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over central parts of Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.
Day 1(10.07.2022) to Day 4(13.07.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Kerala-Karnataka coast, adjoining southeast and eastcentral Arabian sea and Lakshadweep area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.

HIGH WAVE **WARNING** ISSUED BY INCOIS

Karnataka: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.0 meters are predicted during 17:30 hours on 09-07-2022 to 2330 hours of 11-07-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 61 - 75 cm/sec.

Lakshadweep: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.7 meters are forecasted during 02:30 hours on 10-07-2022 to 23:30 hours of 11-07-2022 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 56 - 68 cm/sec.

Andhra Pradesh: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.0 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 09-07-2022 to 23:30 hours of 11-07-2022 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh between Dugarajapatnam to Baruva. Current speeds vary between 73 - 121 cm/sec.

Kerala: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.7 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 09-07-2022 to 2330 hours of 11-07-2022 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod. Current speeds vary between 61 - 75 cm/sec.
