<u>Karnataka</u>: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.0 meters are predicted during 17:30 hours on 09-07-2022 to 2330 hours of 11-07-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 61 - 75 cm/sec.
