DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(01.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over South Bay of Bengal. Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar and Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 2(02.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over South West Bay of Bengal. Strong wing with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar and Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 3(03.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over South West Bay of Bengal and adjoining West Central Bay. Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar and Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 4 (04.08.2022) & Day 5 (05.08.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over South West Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.

Day 1(01.08.2022) & Day 2(02.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Kerala-Karnataka coasts, Lakshadweep area, Maldives, and Southeast Arabian sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 3(03.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Kerala-Karnataka coasts, Lakshadweep area, Maldives, Southeast Arabian sea, West Central Bay off South Andhra Pradesh Coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 4 (04.08.2022) & Day 5 (05.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Kerala-Karnataka coasts, Lakshadweep area, Maldives, and Southeast Arabian sea.
