South Tamilnadu: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.4 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 17-11-2021 to 23:30 hours of 18-11-2021 off Southern Tamil Nadu coast (from Kolachal to Kilakarai). Surface Current speeds vary between 44 - 76 cm/sec.

<u>Andhra Pradesh</u>: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.4 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 17-11-2021 to 23:30 hours of 18-11-2021 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh between Dugarajapatnam to Baruva. Current speeds vary between 75-175 cm/sec.
