Day 2 (05.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar and Southwest Bay off Srilanka coast, Southwest Bay of Bengal, adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.</b>

Day 3(06.08.2022) to Day 5(08.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 Kmph is likely to prevail over Eastcentral Arabian sea and North Andhra Pradesh coast. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.</b>

### HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS

**South Tamilnadu:** High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.7 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 05-08-2022 along the Kolachal to Kilakarai of Southern Tamil Nadu. Current speeds vary between 64 - 97 cm/sec.

**Karnataka:** High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.8 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 05-08-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 48 - 70 cm/sec.

**Lakshadweep:** High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.0 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 05-08-2022 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 44 - 67 cm/sec.

**Kerala:** High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.6 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 05-08-2022 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod. Current speeds vary between 67 - 94 cm/sec.
