South Tamilnadu: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.7 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 05-08-2022 along the Kolachal to Kilakarai of Southern Tamil Nadu. Current speeds vary between 64 - 97 cm/sec.

<u>Karnataka</u>: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.8 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 05-08-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 48 - 70 cm/sec.

Lakshadweep: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.0 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 05-08-2022 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 44 - 67 cm/sec.
