HEAVY TO VERY HEAVY RAINFALL WARNING UPDATE

Realised Rainfall Reports	<p>Recurrent <i>moderate</i> rainfall activity at <i>many</i> places with <i>isolated heavy to very heavy</i> rain occurred over the coastal and adjoining districts of Tamil Nadu; Puducherry and Karaikal during the past 9 days.</p> <p>Significant rainfall during the past 9 days as on 24 hrs ending 0830 IST of 29.10.21 to 06.11.21, depicted in map form, are given in Appendix-1.</p> <p><u>Significant rainfall (mm) during 08:30 IST to 21:00 IST of 06.11.21:</u></p> <p>Ennore port -AWS (Chennai district): 61.0 ACS Medical college -ARG (Kanchipuram district): 32.5 Aruppokottai-KVK (Virudunagar district): 23.5 Villivakkam (Thiruvallur district): 26.5</p>
Forecast	<p>Convective cells over Chennai, Tiruvallur, Kanchipuram, Chengalpattu, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Tiruchirapalli, Nilgiris, Coimbatore, Tiruppur, Erode, Karur, Namakkal, Theni, Dindugul, Madurai, Virudunagar, Sivaganga, Kanyakumari, Tirunelveli, Thenkasi, Thootukoodi and Ramanathapuram districts of Tamil nadu and Puducherry are likely to cause intense rain spells in some places in these districts during the next 3 hours.</p>
