FISHERMEN WARNING

DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 2(17.11.2021) to Day 3(18.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over West-central and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal, South Andhra Pradesh and North Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.

DAY	FOR COASTS OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY
	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Southeast and adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal & Andaman Sea.
Day 1(16.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Eastcentral Arabian Sea and Karnataka coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.

WARNINGS AND **ALERTS** ISSUED BY **INCOIS**

North Tamilnadu: High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.4 meters are forecasted during till 23:30 hours of 17-11-2021 off Northern Tamil Nadu coast (from Point Calimer to Pulicat). Surface Current speeds vary between 75 - 195 cm/sec.

Kerala: High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.2 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 17-11-2021 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod. Current speeds vary between 63 - 76 cm/sec.

<u>Karnataka</u>: High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.2 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 17-11-2021 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar. Current speeds vary between 49 - 56 cm/sec.

<u>Andhra Pradesh:</u> High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.4 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 15-11-2021 to 23:30 hours of 17-11-2021 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh between Dugarajapatnam to Baruva. Current speeds vary between 75-175 cm/sec.
