DAILY WEATHER BULLETIN FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY

Summary of observations over Tamil Nadu and Puducherry recorded at 0830 hrs IST:

Dry weather prevailed over Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TAMILNADU AND PUDUCHERRY FOR NEXT FIVE DAYS

Day 1 (02.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at a few places over coastal Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area.
Day 2 (03.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at many places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area. Heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Mayiladuthurai, Nagapattinam, Cuddalore and Karaikal area. Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, Pudukottai, Kallakurichi, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Villupuram, Chengalpattu districts and Puducherry.
Day 3 (04.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at most places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area. Heavy to very heavy with isolated extremely rainfall is likely to occur over Villupuram, Cuddalore, Kallakurichi districts and Puducherry. Heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Mayiladuthurai, Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, Nagapattinam, Chengalpattu and Kancheepuram districts and Karaikal area. Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Chennai, Tiruvallur, Ranipettai, Tirupattur, Tiruchirapalli, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Vellore, Tiruvannamalai districts.
Day 4 (05.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at most places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal area. Heavy to very heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Tiruvallur, Kancheepuram, Ranipettai and Chengalpattu districts. Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Chennai, Vellore, Kallakurichi, Tirupattur, Tiruvannamalai, Villupuram, Cuddalore districts and Puducherry.
Day 5 (06.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at a few places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal area. Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over interior Tamil Nadu.

HEAVY RAINFALL WARNING:

Day 2(03.03.2022): Heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Mayiladuthurai, Nagapattinam, Cuddalore and Karaikal area. Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, Pudukottai, Kallakurichi, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Villupuram, Chengalpattu districts and Puducherry.

Day 3(04.03.2022): Heavy to very heavy with isolated extremely rainfall is likely to occur over Villupuram, Cuddalore, Kallakurichi districts and Puducherry. Heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Mayiladuthurai, Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, Nagapattinam, Chengalpattu and Kancheepuram districts and Karaikal area. Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Chennai, Tiruvallur, Ranipettai, Tirupattur, Tiruchirapalli, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Vellore, Tiruvannamalai districts.

Day 4(05.03.2022): Heavy to very heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Tiruvallur, Kancheepuram, Ranipettai and Chengalpattu districts. Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Chennai, Vellore, Kallakurichi, Tirupattur, Tiruvannamalai, Villupuram, Cuddalore districts and Puducherry.

Day 5(06.03.2022): Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over interior Tamil Nadu.

THUNDERSTORM WARNING:

Day 1(02.03.2022) to Day 5 (06.03.2022): Thunderstorm with lightening is likely to occur at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area.

LOCAL FORECAST FOR CHENNAI CITY AND NEIGHBOURHOOD:

For next 24 HRS: Sky condition is likely to be partly cloudy. Maximum and minimum temperature is likely to be around 32°C and 22°C respectively.

For next 48 HRS: Sky condition is likely to be partly cloudy. Light rain is likely to occur in some areas. Maximum and minimum temperature is likely to be around 32°C and 22°C respectively.
