DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(28.06.2022) & Day 2 (29.06.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar, adjoining South Tamilnadu coast and southwest Bay off Srilanka coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.
Day 3 (30.06.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar, Tamilnadu coast and adjoining southwest Bay off Srilanka coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.

Day 2(29.06.2022) & Day 3(30.06.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Lakshadweep area, Kerala coast, adjoining southeast Arabian sea, Karnataka coast and adjoining Eastcentral Arabian sea. HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

LAKSHADWEEP: High waves in the range of 3.4 - 3.8 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours on 28-06-2021 along with Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra.
Current speeds vary between 34 - 60 cm/sec.

HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS

KARNATAKA: High waves in the range of 3.1 - 3.5 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 28-06-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast.
Current speeds vary between 29 - 51 cm/sec.
