WARNINGS FOR FISHERMEN

The **deep depression** over northwest & adjoining west-central bay of bengal moved westwards with a speed of 17 kmph in last 6 hours and lay centered at 0600 utc of 25th september 2021, over northwest and adjoining west-central bay of bengal near lat. 18.4°n and long. 88.7°e, about 410 km east-southeast of gopalpur & 480 km east-northeast of Kalingapatnam. It is likely to intensify into a **cyclonic storm** during next 06 hours. It is likely to move nearly westwards and cross north andhra pradesh - south odisha coasts between kalingapatnam & gopalpur by evening of 26th september, 2021.

COAST	WIND WARNINGS
Tamil Nadu & Puducherry	<p><u>Day 2(26.09.2021) to Day 3(27.09.2021):</u> Strong wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar and Southwest Bay of Bengal.</p> <p>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the period mentioned above.</p>
Other than Tamil Nadu	<p><u>Day 1(25.09.2021):</u> Squally Wind (wind speed 40-50 kmph to gusting 60 kmph) very likely over the Southwest, Southeast, Westcentral & Northeast Arabian Sea, Northeast & Eastcentral Bay of Bengal, Southwest and adjoining Southeast Bay, Gulf of Mannar & Comorin area and (speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph) over Northwest and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal and along & off south OdishaNorth Andhra Pradesh-West Bengal coasts. Squally wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph very likely over Northwest and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal and increase gradually becoming gale wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph from the evening. Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely along and off Odisha-North Andhra Pradesh coasts from today morning.</p> <p><u>Day 2(26.09.2021) to Day 3(27.09.2021):</u> Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to occur over Kerala, Lakshadweep area, Southeast Arabian Sea and Maldives area.</p> <p>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the period mentioned above.</p>

HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

ANDHRA PRADESH: High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.5 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 25-09-2021 to 23:30 hours of 26-09-2021 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh from Visakhapatnam to Baruva. Surface Current speeds vary between 101 - 152 cm/sec.
