Sub: Special message regarding maximum temperatures over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal

Maximum temperatures observed during the past 24 hours:

During the 24-hr ending 08:30 IST of today (**12.04.2024**), the maximum temperatures over Tamilnadu were generally **above normal to appreciably above normal by 2-4**°C over a few pockets in the plains of interior Tamilnadu. They were normal to above normal (1-3°C above normal) over the coastal areas of Tamilnadu and near normal over Puducherry & Karaikal areas.

Highest maximum temperature was recorded at Tirupattur: 41.6°C (+4.5°C) followed by Erode:40.0°C (+2.4°C). Plains of the rest of interior Tamilnadu recorded 37-40°C.


The coastal areas of Tamilnadu recorded 33°C to 37°C and the hilly areas, 21°C to 31°C (normal to above normal maximum temperatures).

Chennai recorded normal maximum temperature (MBK:36.0°C and NBK:34.9°C).


Temperature & Humidity Forecast and warning for next five days:


Maximum Temperature: **Forecast** Dav-1-Dav-5 Slight fall in maximum temperature over South Tamilnadu & western ghat districts of North Tamilnadu and no large change over rest of Tamilnadu, (12.04.2024 to 16.04.2024) Puducherry & Karaikal during the next two days and gradual rise by 2-3°C during the subsequent three days. 12.04.2024-13.04.2024: Maximum temperature is likely to be 2-3°C above normal at a few pockets over north Tamilnadu and near normal over Puducherry& Karaikal during the next two days. It is likely to be 37°C to 40°C at many pockets over the plains of the north interior districts; and 33°C to 37°C over most pockets in south Tamilnadu and north coastal areas of Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal. 14.04.2024-16.04.2024: It is likely to be 2-4°C above normal at many pockets over Tamilnadu during the subsequent three days. It is likely to be 38°C to 41°C at many pockets over the plains of the interior districts; and 34°C to 38°C over most pockets in the coastal areas of Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.







Maximum temperature forecast for the next five days











ADVISE FOR MINIMISING IMPACTS DUE TO HEAT STRESS

- Avoid going out in the sun, especially between 12.00 noon and 3.00 p.m.
- Drink sufficient water and as often as possible, even if not thirsty
- Wear lightweight, light-coloured, loose, and porous cotton clothes. Use protective goggles, umbrella/hat, shoes or chappals while going out in sun.
- Avoid strenuous activities when the outside temperature is high. Avoid working outside between 12 noon and 3 p.m.
- While travelling, carry water with you.
- If you work outside, use a hat or an umbrella and also use a damp cloth on your head, neck, face and limbs.
- Do not leave children or pets in parked vehicles.
- If you feel faint or ill, see a doctor immediately.
- Use ORS, homemade drinks like lassi, torani (rice water), lemon water, buttermilk, etc. which helps to re-hydrate the body.
- Keep animals in shade and give them plenty of water to drink.
- Keep your home cool, use curtains, shutters or sunshade and open windows at night.
- Use fans, damp clothing and take bath in cold water frequently.

TIPS FOR TREATMENT OF A PERSON AFFECTED BY A SUNSTROKE

- Lay the person in a cool place, under a shade. Wipe her/him with a wet cloth/wash the body frequently. Pour normal temperature water on the head. The main thing is to bring down the body temperature.
- Give the person ORS to drink or lemon sarbat/torani or whatever is useful to rehydrate the body.
- Take the person immediately to the nearest health centre. The patient needs immediate hospitalisation, as heat strokes could be fatal.

ACCLIMATISATION

People at risk are those who have come from a cooler climate to a hot climate. You may have such a person(s) visiting your family during the heat wave season. They should not move about in open field for a period of one week till the body is acclimatized to heat and should drink plenty of water. Acclimatization is achieved by gradual exposure to the hot environment during heat wave.
