DAILY WEATHER BULLETIN FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY

Summary of observations over Tamil Nadu and Puducherry recorded at 0830 hrs IST:

Rainfall occurred at one or two places over South Tamilnadu. Dry weather prevailed over North Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area.

CHIEF AMOUNT OF RAINFALL IN CENTIMETERS: Nil

DESCRIPTION OF TEMPERATURE:

During the 24-hr ending 08:30 IST of today (28.04.2024), the maximum temperatures over Tamilnadu were generally **above normal to appreciably above normal 3 to 4°C** over a many pockets in the plains of interior Tamilnadu. They were **normal to above normal (1-3°C)** over the coastal areas of Tamilnadu and near normal over Puducherry & Karaikal area.

Eight stations recorded maximum temperature above 40°C.

Highest maximum temperature recorded at **Erode 42.4°C** (+4.0°C).

Salem: 41.9°C (+4.2°C), Tirupattur: 41.8°C (+4.0°C), Dharmapuri: 41.0°C (+3.9°C), Karur Paramathi: 40.5 °C (+3.4°C), Tiruttani: 40.2°C (+1.3°C), Vellore: 40.1°C (+1.3°C) and Namakkal: 40.0°C.

Plains of the rest of Interior Tamilnadu recorded 38-40°C.

The coastal areas of Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal recorded 35°C to 38°C and the hilly areas, 23°C to 30°C temperatures.

Chennai recorded normal maximum (MBK: 36.7°C, +0.0°C and NBK: 35.2°C, -0.4°C).

Synoptic Meteorological feature:

Yesterday's trough/wind discontinuity from Marathwada to north Tamil Nadu now runs from eastern parts of Vidarbha to north Kerala across Madhya Maharashtra, interior Karnataka and extends upto 1.5 km above mean sea level.

A cyclonic circulation lies over Gulf of Mannar & neighbourhood at 0.9 km above mean sea level. Yesterday's cyclonic circulation over Comorin area & neighbourhood at 0.9 km above mean sea level has become less marked.
