DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(25.06.2022) to Day 3(27.06.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar, Tamilnadu Coast and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period

DAY	FOR OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(25.06.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Lakshadweep area, Kerala - Karnataka coast, adjoining Southeast Arabian Sea and Eastcentral Arabian sea. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over North Andhra Pradesh coast and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal. HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

KARNATAKA: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.7 meters are predicted during 17:30 hours on 25-06-2022 to 2330 hours of 27-06-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast.
Current speeds vary between 25 - 37 cm/sec.
LAKSHADWEEP: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.8 meters are forecasted from 17:30 hours on 25-06-2022 to 23:30 hours on 27-06-2021 along with Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra.
Current speeds vary between 32 - 59 cm/sec.
