### HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

**Karnataka:** High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.6 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 16-07-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 49 - 69 cm/sec.  
**Lakshadweep:** High waves in the range of 3.0 - 4.0 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 16-07-2022 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 47 - 64 cm/sec.  
**Kerala:** High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.9 meters are forecasted during till 2330 hours of 16-07-2022 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod. Current speeds vary between 49 - 79 cm/sec.
