DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(23.06.2022) & Day 2(24.06.2022)	Strong winds with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar, south Tamilnadu coast and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.
Day 3(25.06.2022) to Day 5(27.06.2022)	Nil.

DAY	FOR OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(23.06.2022) & Day 2(24.06.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Karnataka coast & adjoining Eastcentral Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.
Day 3(25.06.2022) & Day 4(26.06.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Lakshadweep area, Kerala coast and adjoining Southeast Arabian Sea, Karnataka coast & adjoining Eastcentral Arabian sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.

HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

LAKSHADWEEP: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.7 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours on 25-06-2021 along with Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 25 - 80 cm/sec.

HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS

KARNATAKA: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.2 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 25-06-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast.
Current speeds vary between 24 - 33 cm/sec.
KERALA: High waves in the range of 2.8 - 3.1 meters are forecasted till 2330 hours of 25-06-2022 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod.
Current speeds vary between 36 - 60 cm/sec.
