Subject: Enhanced rainfall activity over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during the next five days

Rainfall occurred at *many* places over Coastal Tamilnadu, at *a few* places over South Interior Tamilnadu and over Karaikal area during the past 24 hours ending 08:30 IST of 17.05.2024.

Isolated heavy occurred over Kanyakumari district during the same period.

Under the influence of upper air cyclonic circulations over Tamilnadu and neighbourhood, *light* to *moderate* rainfall at *many* places with *isolated heavy* to *very heavy* rain, *thunderstorm and lightning* with strong winds, speeding reaching 30-40 kmph is likely over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during the next five days (17.05.2024 to 21.05.2024) as detailed below:


