### HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS

**South Tamilnadu:** High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.6 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 04-08-2022 along the Kolachal to Kilakarai of Southern Tamil Nadu.
