DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(03.08.2022) & Day 2 (04.08.2022)	Strong wind speed reaching 50-60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar and Southwest Bay off Srilanka coast. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 50-60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Southwest Bay of Bengal, adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas during the mentioned period.
Day 3 (05.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 50-60 Kmph is likely to prevail over South-west Bay of Bengal, adjoining West-central Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 4(06.08.2022) & Day 5(07.08.2022)	Nil

DAY	FOR OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(03.08.2022) & Day 2 (04.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 50-60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Kerala-Karnataka coasts, Lakshadweep area and adjoining Southeast Arabian sea, South Andhra Pradesh coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas during the mentioned period.
Day 3 (05.08.2022)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 50-60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Karnataka coast, adjoining Eastcentral Arabian sea and South Andhra Pradesh coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.

HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS

South Tamilnadu: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.6 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 04-08-2022 along the Kolachal to Kilakarai of Southern Tamil Nadu. Current speeds vary between 70 - 103 cm/sec.
Karnataka: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.6 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 04-08-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 43 - 55 cm/sec.
Lakshadweep: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.2 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 04-08-2022 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 47 - 60 cm/sec.
