DAILY WEATHER BULLETIN FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY

A depression has formed over southwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining Equatorial Indian Ocean at 0530 hrs IST of today and now lay centered at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 3rd March 2022, over the same region near latitude 5.6°N and longitude 83.7°E, about 420 km south-southeast of Trincomalee (Sri Lanka), 760 km south-southeast of Nagapattinam (Tamil Nadu), 820 km south-southeast of Puducherry (Tamil Nadu) and about 900 km south-southeast of Chennai (Tamil Nadu). It is likely to intensify further into a Deep Depression during next 24 hours. It is likely to move northwestwards along and off east coast of Sri Lanka towards north Tamil Nadu Coast during next 48 hours.

Summary of observations over Tamil Nadu and Puducherry recorded at 0830 hrs IST:

Dry weather prevailed over Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TAMILNADU AND PUDUCHERRY FOR NEXT FIVE DAYS

Day 1 (03.03.2022)	Light to moderate rain is likely to occur at a few places over coastal Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area. Light rain is likely to occur at isolated places over interior Tamilnadu.
Day 2 (04.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at many places over coastal Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area and at a few places over interior Tamilnadu. Thunderstorm with heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Pudukottai, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Chengalpattu & delta districts of Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area.
Day 3 (05.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at most places over coastal Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area and at a few places over interior Tamilnadu. Thunderstorm with heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Pudukottai, Cuddalore, Villupuram & delta districts of Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area. Thunderstorm with heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram, Kallakurichi, Tiruvannamalai, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Tiruchirapalli districts of Tamilnadu.
Day 4 (06.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at many places over coastal Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area and at a few places over interior Tamilnadu. Thunderstorm with heavy to very heavy rainfall

	is likely to occur at isolated places over Cuddalore, Villupuram and Kallakurichi districts of Tamilnadu and Puducherry area. Thunderstorm with heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram, Tiruvannamalai and Ranipet districts of Tamilnadu.
Day 5 (07.03.2022)	Thunderstorm with light to moderate rain is likely to occur at many places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal area. Thunderstorm with heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over north interior Tamil Nadu.

HEAVY RAINFALL WARNING:

Day 2(04.03.2022): Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Pudukottai, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Chengalpattu, delta districts of Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area.

Day 3(05.03.2022): Heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Pudukottai, Cuddalore, Villupuram, delta districts, Puducherry and Karaikal area. Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram, Kallakurichi, Tiruvannamalai, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Tiruchirapalli districts.

Day 4(06.03.2022): Heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Cuddalore, Villupuram and Kallakurichi districts of Tamilnadu and Puducherry area. Thunderstorm with heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram, Tiruvannamalai and Ranipet districts of Tamilnadu.

Day 5(07.03.2022): Heavy rain is also likely to occur at isolated places over north interior Tamil Nadu.

THUNDERSTORM WARNING:

Day 2(04.03.2022) to Day 5 (07.03.2022): Thunderstorm with lightening is likely to occur at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area.

LOCAL FORECAST FOR CHENNAI CITY AND NEIGHBOURHOOD:

For next 24 HRS: Sky condition is likely to be generally cloudy. Light rain is likely to occur in some areas. Maximum and minimum temperature is likely to be around 31°C and 23°C respectively.

For next 48 HRS: Sky condition is likely to be generally cloudy. Light to moderate rain is likely to occur in some areas. Maximum and minimum temperature is likely to be around 30°C and 23°C respectively.
