FISHERMEN WARNING

The **Deep Depression** over southwest Bay of Bengal weakened into a Depression at 2330 hours IST of 5th March 2022, over southwest Bay of Bengal and moved nearly southwestwards and weakened into a Well Marked Low Pressure Area over the same region at 0830 hours IST of today, the 06th March 2022. It is very likely to move further southwestwards towards north Tamil Nadu Coast and weaken gradually into a low pressure area during next 24 hours.

DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(06.03.2022)	Squally winds speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph would prevail over Southwest & adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal, Gulf of Mannar and along & off Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & South Andhra Pradesh coasts during next 12 hours. The wind speed would gradually decrease becoming strong winds 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph thereafter during subsequent 12 hours. Sea condition will be rough over Southwest & adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal, Gulf of Mannar and Comorin area and along & off Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & south Andhra Pradesh coasts till 7 th March morning and improve thereafter.

Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the above mentioned period. Fishermen at sea are advised to return to the coast immediately.

WARNINGS AND ALERTS ISSUED BY INCOIS

<u>ANDHRA PRADESH</u>: High waves in the range of 1.5-4.0 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours on 06-03-2022 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh between Dugarajapatnam to Barua.
