FISHERMEN WARNING

DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(12.11.2021)	Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over gulf of Mannar. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.

DAY	FOR COASTS OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY
Day 2(13.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over south Andaman Sea.
Day 3(14.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 Kmph is likely to prevail over south Andaman Sea and adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal.
Day 4(15.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 Kmph is likely to prevail over southeast and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal.
Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the above mentioned period.	

WARNINGS AND ALERTS ISSUED BY INCOIS

North Tamilnadu: High waves in the range of 2.5-3.7 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 12-11-2021 off Northern Tamil Nadu coast (from Point Calimer to Pulicat). Surface Current speeds vary between 75 - 195 cm/sec.

South Tamilnadu: High waves in the range of 3.0-3.6 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 12-11-2021 off Southern Tamil Nadu coast (from Kolachal to Kilakarai). Current speeds vary between 44 - 76 cm/sec.

Andhra Pradesh: High waves in the range of 3.0-3.6 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 12-11-2021 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh between Dugarajapatnam to Baruva. Current speeds vary between 75-175 cm/sec.
