WARNING FOR FISHERMEN FOR TAMILNADU AND PUDUCHERRY

INFORMATION ON DEEP DEPRESSION OVER BAY OF BENGAL:

The Deep Depression still remains quasi stationary and lying close to coastal area of Ramanathapuram Districts and weakens into depression in the same area during next 12 hrs. It will further weaken into well marked low pressure area and slowly move west southwest ward across Ramanathapuram District towards south Kerala. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph likely over Tamil Nadu coast and Gulf of Mannar. Wave height reach up to 4 m occasionally between Kolachal and Dhanushkodi and 4.3 m between Kodiakkarai and Pazhaverkadu. Fishermen are advised not to venture in to these areas for next 24 hrs.

Tamil Nadu & Puducherry	Day 1 (04.12.2020): Squally wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is very likely over Gulf of Mannar and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal, along & off south Tamilnadu coast (Ramanathapuram, Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli and Kanniyakumari districts).

WARNING FOR FISHERMEN FOR OTHER THAN TAMILNADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS

Day 1(04.12.2020): Squally wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is very likely over west Sri Lanka coast.

Fishermen are advised not to venture into the sea in above mentioned areas for the period mentioned.

HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS:

NORTH TAMILNADU: High waves in the range of 2.0-4.3 meters are forecasted upto 23:30 hours of 04-12-2020 along the coast of North Tamil Nadu from Calimer to Pulicat. Surface Current speeds vary between 56 - 64 cm/sec.

SOUTH TAMILNADU: High waves in the range of 2.0-4.0 meters are forecasted upto 23:30 hours of 04-12-2020 along the coast of South Tamil Nadu from Kolachal to Dhanushkodi. Surface Current speeds vary between 56 - 64 cm/sec.

<u>ANDHRA PRADESH</u>: High waves in the range of 2.3-3.5 meters are forecasted during upto 23:30 hours of 04-12-2020 along the coast of south Andhra Pradesh from Machilipatnam to Dugarajapatnam.
