WARNING FOR FISHERMEN

COAST	WIND WARNINGS
Tamil Nadu & Puducherry	 Day 1(11.07.2021): Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely over Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu coast and Andaman sea. Day 1(11.07.2021) to Day 2(12.07.2021): Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely over Gulf of Mannar, Comorin area and south Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised NOT TO venture into these sea areas during the period mentioned.
Other than Tamil Nadu	 Day 1(11.07.2021) to Day 3(13.07.2021): Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph likely over Kerala-Karnataka coasts and Lakshadweep area and adjoining Arabian sea. Day 1(11.07.2021) to Day 5(15.07.2021): Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph likely over South west and west central Arabian sea. Fishermen are advised NOT TO venture into these sea areas during the period mentioned.

HIGH WAVE WARNING - ISSUED BY INCOIS

<u>Karnataka:</u> High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.9 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 13-07-2021 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 51 - 76 cm/sec.

HIGH WAVE ALERT - ISSUED BY INCOIS

<u>Kerala:</u> High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.5 meters are forecasted till 2330 hours of 13-07-2021 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod. Current speeds vary between 65 - 79 cm/sec.

<u>South Tamilnadu:</u> High waves in the range of 2.5 - 3.1 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 13-07-2021 along the Kolachal to Kilakarai of Southern Tamil Nadu. Current speeds vary between 49 - 69 cm/sec.
