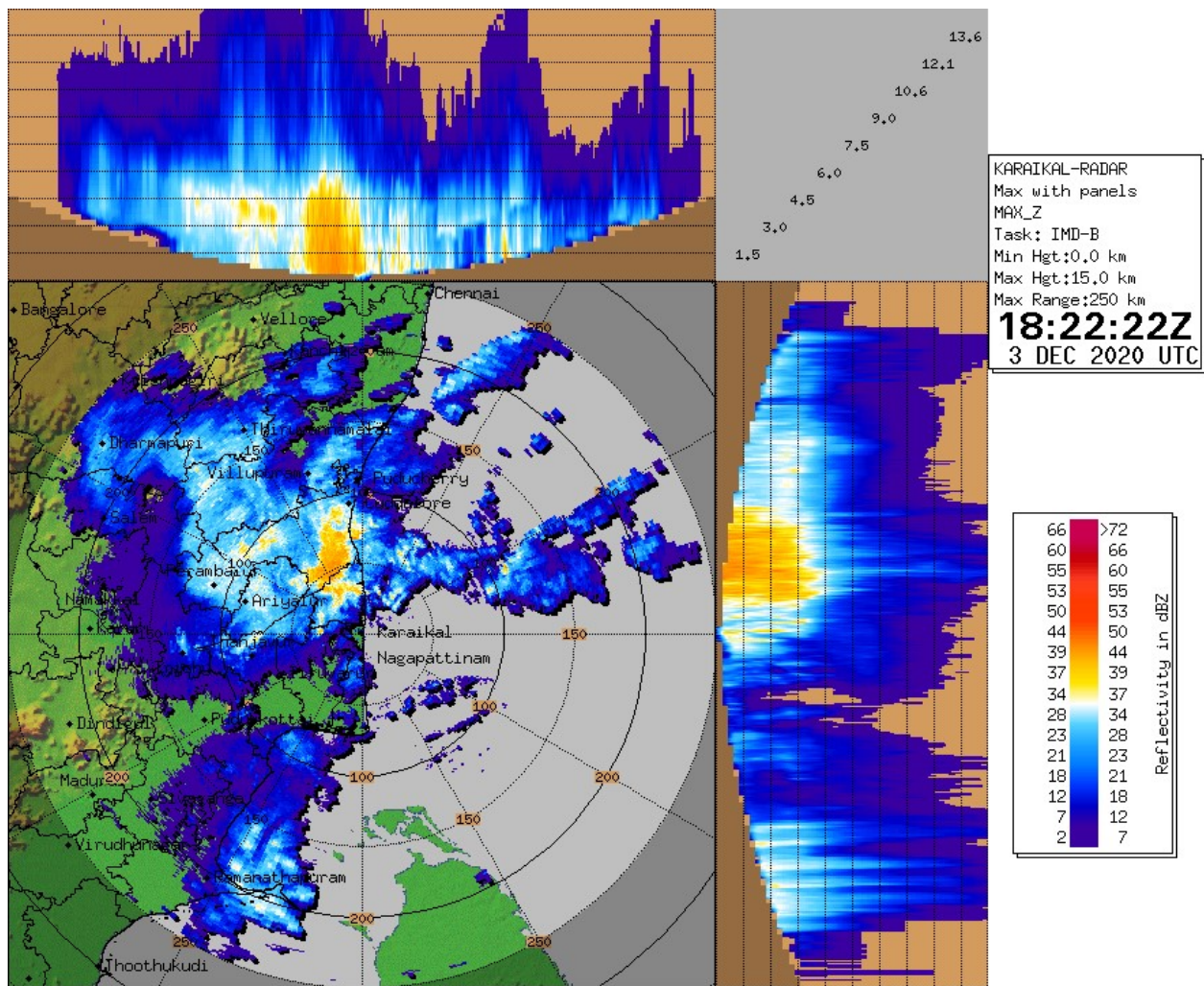

Forecast / Nowcast	<p>As per latest observations, intense convective clouds present over Tiruchirapalli, Thanjavur, Thiruvavur, Ariyalore, Perambalare, Cuddalore, Viluppuram, Ramanathapuram, Nagapattinam, Sivangai, Kanchipuram districts of Tamilnadu , Puduchery and Karaikal areas, have the potential to cause heavy to very heavy rainfall during the next three hrs. (Likelihood: Medium)</p>
