### HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS

**South Tamilnadu:** High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.6 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 04-08-2022 along the Kolachal to Kilakarai of Southern Tamil Nadu. Current speeds vary between 70 - 103 cm/sec. **Karnataka:** High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.6 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 04-08-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 43 - 55 cm/sec. **Lakshadweep:** High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.2 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 04-08-2022 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 47 - 60 cm/sec.

## HIGH SWELL WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS

**Kerala:** High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.5 meters are forecasted till 2330 hours of 04-08-2022 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod. Current speeds vary between 67 - 92 cm/sec.
