## **WARNINGS FOR FISHERMEN**

The Cyclonic Storm 'Gulab' (pronounced as Gul-Aab) over northwest and adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal moved nearly westwards with a speed of 19 Kmph during last 06 hours and lay centered at 1430 hrs IST of 26<sup>th</sup> September 2021, over northwest and adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal near Lat. 18.4°N and Long. 85.3°E, about 110 km east-southeast of Gopalpur (Odisha) & 130 km east-northeast of Kalingapatnam (Andhra Pradesh).

It is likely to move nearly westwards and cross north Andhra Pradesh - south Odisha coasts between Kalingapatnam & Gopalpur, as a Cyclonic Storm with maximum sustained wind speed of 75-85 Kmph gusting to 95 Kmph by mid-night of today, the 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2021. The Landfall process will commence from the evening of today.

**HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS**

**ANDHRA PRADESH:** High waves in the range of 2.5-4.2 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 27-09-2021 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh from Visakhapatnam to Baruva. Surface Current speeds vary between 75 - 165 cm/sec.

**ODISHA:** High waves in the range of 2.5-4.0 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 27-09-2021 along the coast of Odisha from Gopalpur to Chandipur. Surface current speeds vary between 75 - 145 cm/sec.

**HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS**

**TAMILNADU:** High waves in the range of 3.0-3.4 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 27-09-2021 along the coast of Southern Tamil Nadu from Kolachal to Dhanushkodi. Surface Current speeds vary between 54 - 74 cm/sec.

**KERALA:** High waves in the range of 2.5-3.3 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 27-09-2021 along the coast of Kerala from Pozhiyoor to Kasargod. Surface Current speeds vary between 54 - 74 cm/sec.
