**Sub: Special message regarding maximum temperatures over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal**

**Maximum temperatures observed during the past 24 hours:**

During the 24-hr ending 08:30 IST of today (01.05.2024), the maximum temperatures over Tamilnadu were generally **above normal to appreciably above normal 2 to 4°C** over few pockets in the plains of interior Tamilnadu. They were **normal to above normal (1-3°C)** over the coastal areas of Tamilnadu and near normal over Puducherry & Karaikal area.

Highest maximum temperature recorded at **Karur Paramathi : 42.5°C (+5.7°C)** followed by **Erode: 42.2 °C (+4.1°C)**, **Tirupattur: 41.8°C (+3.9°C)**, **Vellore: 41.6°C (+2.4°C)**, **Tiruchirappalli\_AP: 41.3°C (+2.9°C)**, **Salem: 40.8°C (+3.2°C)**, **Madurai\_AP: 40.6°C (+2.9°C)**, **Dharmapuri: 40.2°C (+3.3°C)**, **Madurai City: 40.2 (+2.6°C)**, **Tiruthani: 40.2°C (+1.0°C)**, **Namakkal: 40.0°C** and **Thanjavur: 40.0°C**

Plains of **the rest of** Interior Tamilnadu recorded **38-40°C**.

The **coastal areas** of Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal recorded **35°C to 38°C** and the **hilly areas**, **23°C to 30°C** temperatures.

Chennai recorded normal maximum (MBK: 39.4°C, +2.3°C and NBK: 36.9°C, +0.8°C).

(01.05.2024 to 03.05.2024).</b></p> <p>It is likely to be 39-43°C at a few pockets over the plains of the <b>North Interior districts, 38-40°C over the plains of the rest Tamilnadu and 36-39°C over coastal Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Karaikal area during the next five days. (01.05.2024 to 05.05.2024).</b></p> <p><b><u>Relative Humidity</u></b></p> <p>Humidity is likely to be about 30-50% in the afternoon hours and 40-75% during the rest of the day over the plains of interior districts; and 50-80% over the coastal areas during the next five days (01.05.2024 to 05.05.2024).</p>

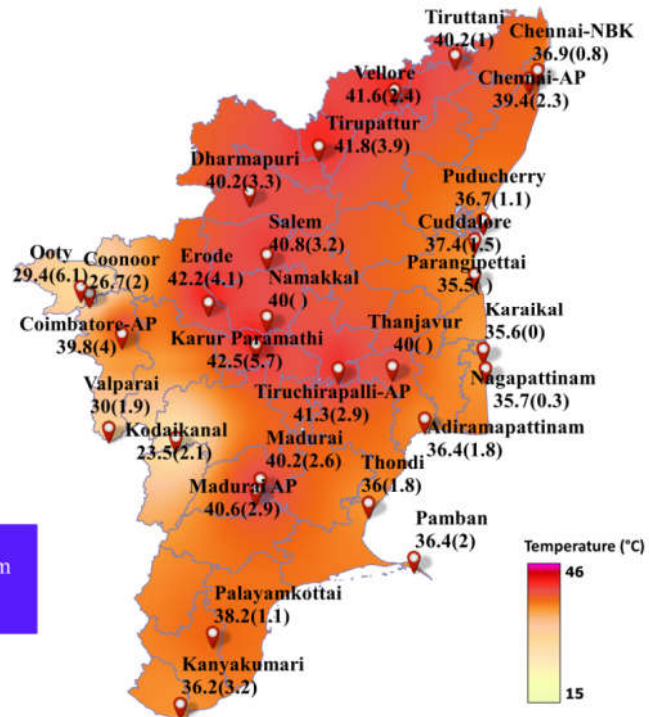
Realised Maximum Temperature ( $^{\circ}\text{C}$ ) in the past 24 Hrs  
(upto 0830 IST of 01/05/2024) and its departure from normal( $^{\circ}\text{C}$ )

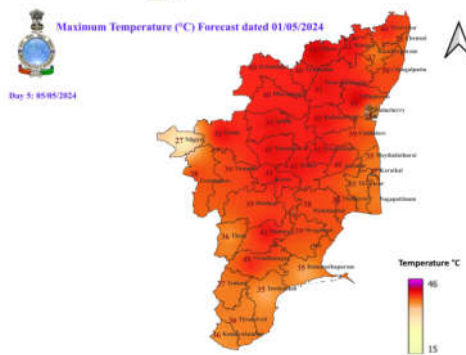
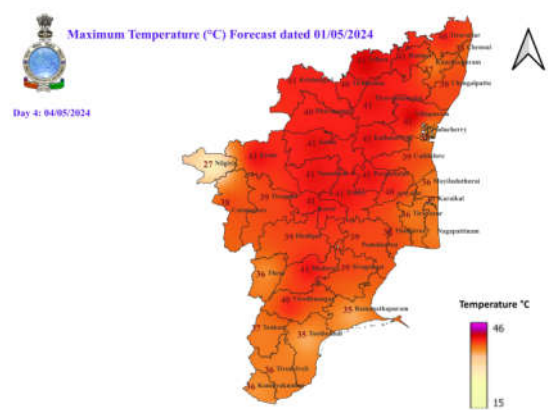
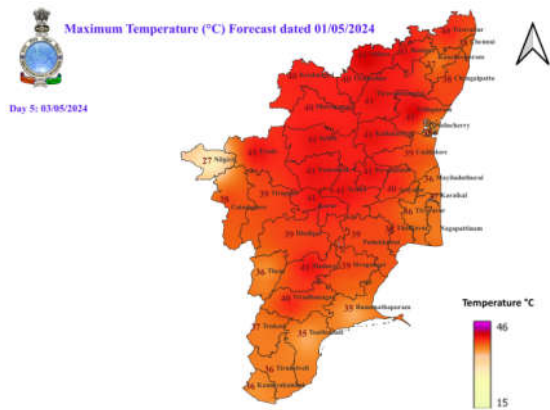
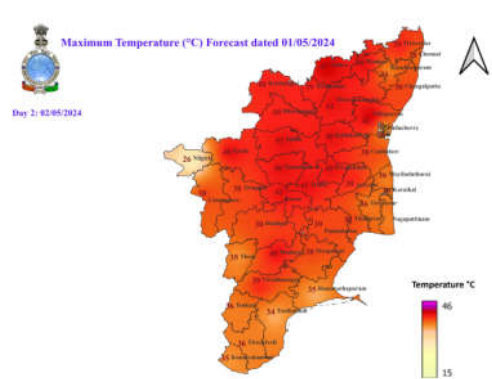
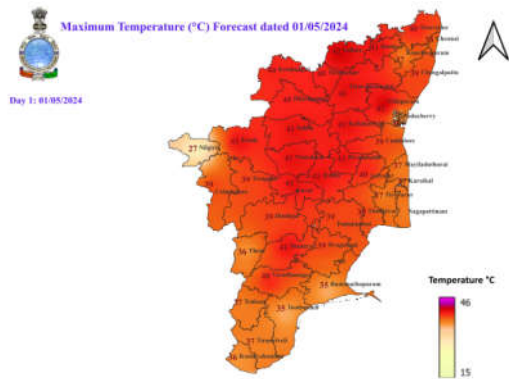

## **ADVISE FOR MINIMISING IMPACTS DUE TO HEAT STRESS**

- Avoid going out in the sun, especially between 12.00 noon and 3.00 p.m.
- Drink sufficient water and as often as possible, even if not thirsty
- Wear lightweight, light-coloured, loose and porous cotton clothes. Use protective goggles, umbrella/hat, shoes or chappals while going out in sun.
- Avoid strenuous activities when the outside temperature is high. Avoid working outside between 12 noon and 3 p.m.
- While travelling, carry water with you.
- If you work outside, use a hat or an umbrella and also use a damp cloth on your head, neck, face and limbs.
- Do not leave children or pets in parked vehicles.
- If you feel faint or ill, see a doctor immediately.
- Use ORS, homemade drinks like lassi, torani (rice water), lemon water, buttermilk, etc. which helps to re-hydrate the body.
- Keep animals in shade and give them plenty of water to drink.
- Keep your home cool, use curtains, shutters or sunshade and open windows at night.
- Use fans, damp clothing and take bath in cold water frequently.

## **TIPS FOR TREATMENT OF A PERSON AFFECTED BY A SUNSTROKE**

- Lay the person in a cool place, under a shade. Wipe her/him with a wet cloth/wash the body frequently. Pour normal temperature water on the head. The main thing is to bring down the body temperature.
- Give the person ORS to drink or lemon sarbat/torani or whatever is useful to rehydrate the body.
- Take the person immediately to the nearest health centre. The patient needs immediate hospitalisation, as heat strokes could be fatal.

## **ACCLIMATISATION**

People at risk are those who have come from a cooler climate to a hot climate. You may have such a person(s) visiting your family during the heat wave season. They should not move about in open field for a period of one week till the body is acclimatized to heat and should drink plenty of water. Acclimatization is achieved by gradual exposure to the hot environment during heat wave.
