Day 1(05.08.2022) to Day 5(09.08.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 50-60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Gulf of Mannar. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.

DAY	FOR OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1(05.08.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Kerala-Karnataka coast, Lakshadweep area and adjoining southeast Arabian sea. Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Eastcentral Arabian sea Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 2(06.08.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Eastcentral Arabian sea. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 Kmph is likely to prevail over North Karnataka coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 3(07.08.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Eastcentral Arabian sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 4(08.08.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Kerala - Karnataka coast, Lakshadweep area & adjoining southeast Arabian sea. Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Eastcentral Arabian sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.
Day 5(09.08.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph is likely to prevail over Kerala - Karnataka coast, Lakshadweep area & adjoining southeast Arabian sea. Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Eastcentral Arabian sea and Northeast Arabian sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas.

HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

Karnataka: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.1 meters are predicted during 17:30 hours on 05-08-2022 to 23:30 hours of 07-08-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast.
Current speeds vary between 61 - 69 cm/sec.

Kerala: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.6 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 05-08-2022 to 23:30 hours of 07-08-2022 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod.
Current speeds vary between 59 - 84 cm/sec.

Lakshadweep: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.2 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 05-08-2022 to 23:30 hours of 07-08-2022 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra.
Current speeds vary between 49 - 80 cm/sec.

Andhra Pradesh: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.3 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 05-08-2022 to 23:30 hours of 07-08-2022 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh between Dugarajapatnam to Baruva.
