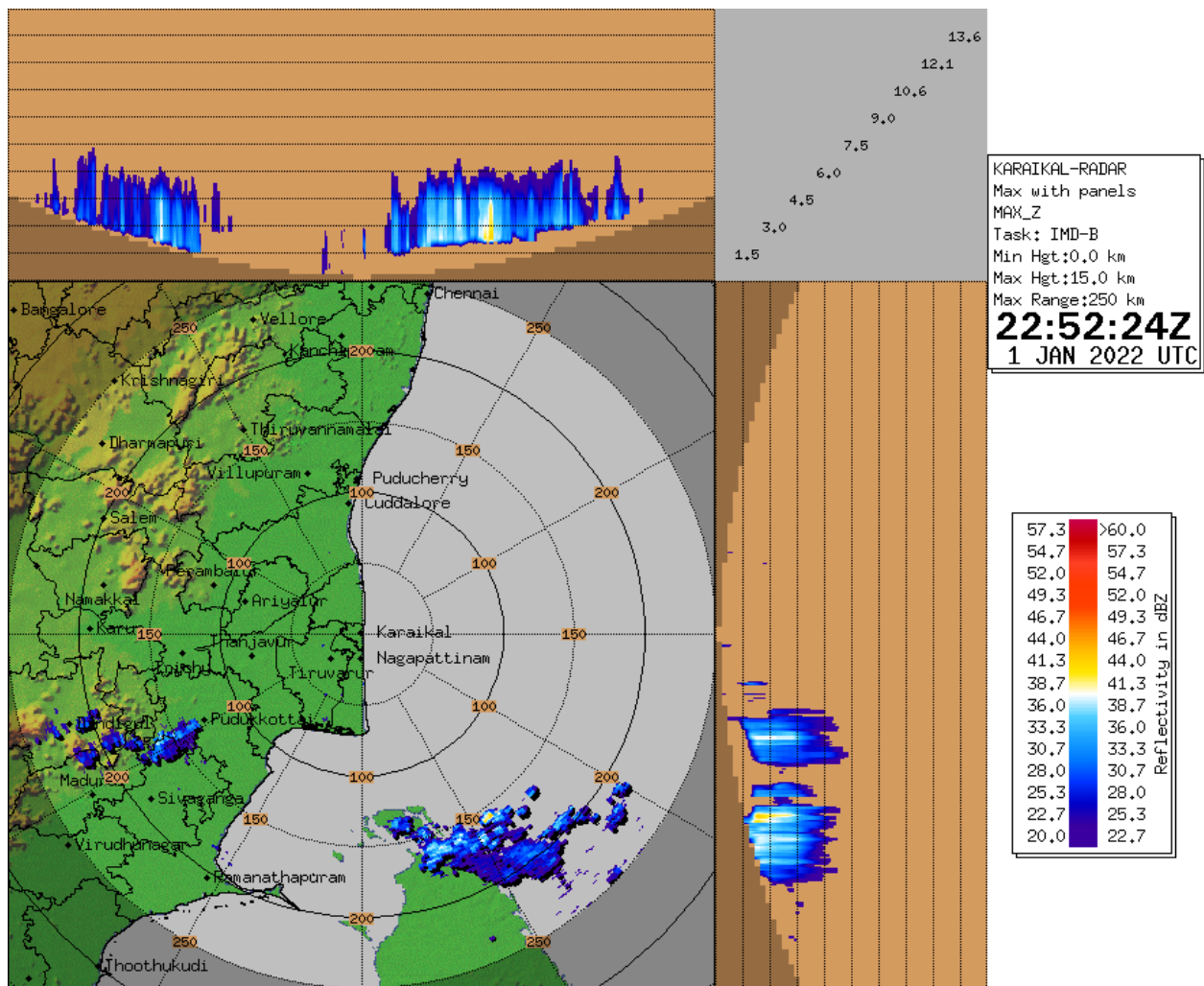

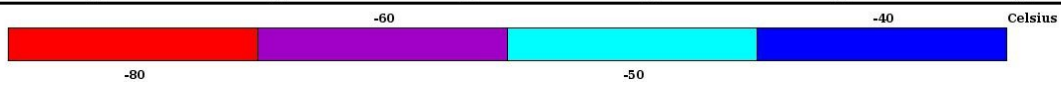
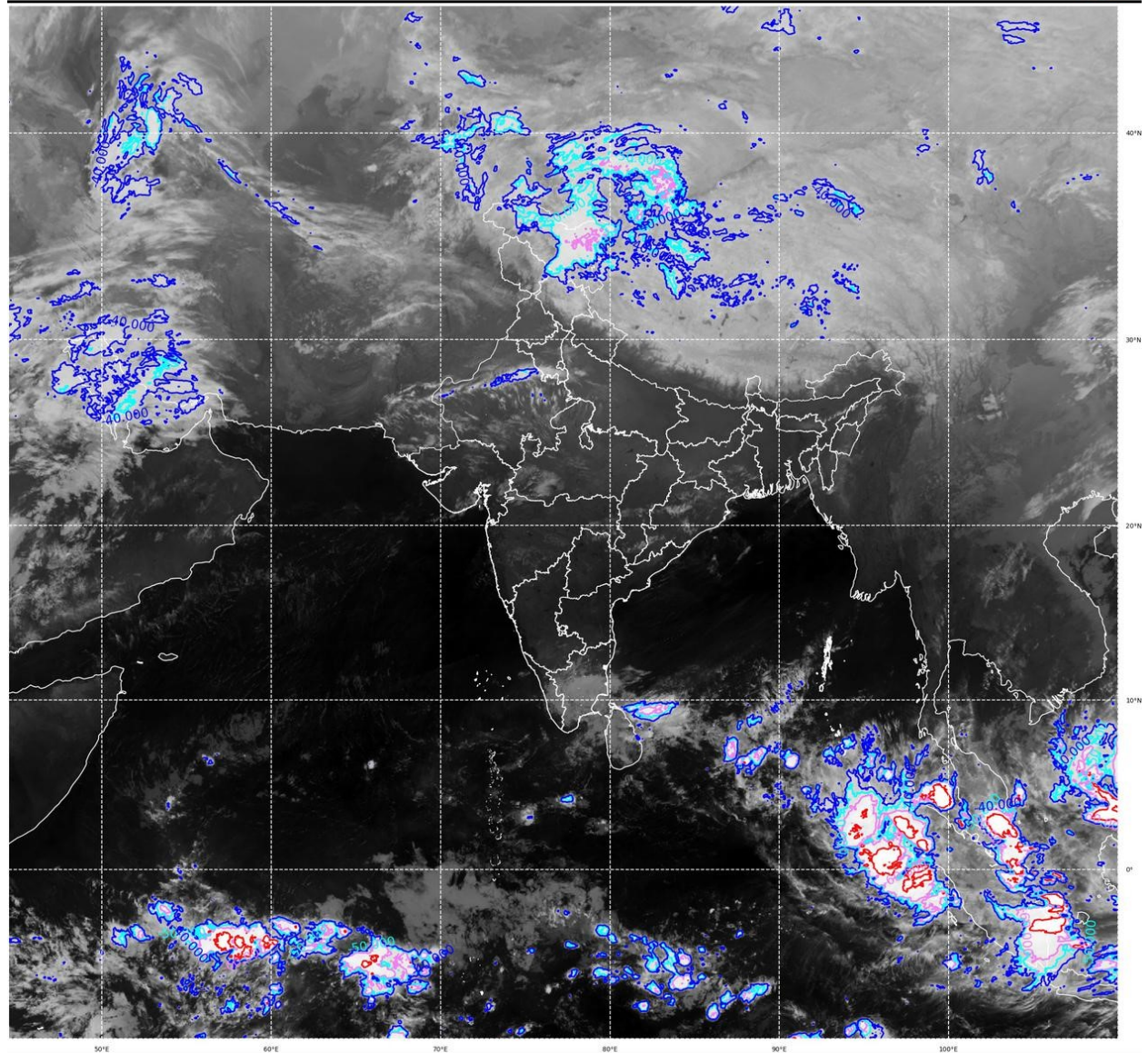

Realised Rainfall Reports	Adhiramapattinam (Thanjavur district): 150.5 mm Vamban (Pudukkottai district): 105.5 mm Perambalur: 67.5 mm
Forecast / Nowcast	As per latest observations, intense convective clouds present over Thanjavur and Pudukottai districts of Tamilnadu have the potential to cause Heavy to Very Heavy rainfall activity during the next three hrs. (Likelihood: Medium)
