Day 1(19.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Tamil Nadu coast for the next 6 hours from 11:00 hrs IST. Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area and Gulf of Mannar. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.

Day 1(19.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph is likely to prevail over Andhra coast for the next 6 hours from 11:00 hrs IST. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.

<u>North Tamilnadu:</u> High waves in the range of 2.5 – 3.4 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 19-11-2021 off Northern Tamil Nadu coast (from Point Calimer to Pulicat). Surface Current speeds vary between 75 - 195 cm/sec.

<u>North Tamilnadu:</u> High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.4 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 19-11-2021 off Southern Tamil Nadu coast (from Kolachal to Kilakarai). Current speeds vary between 44 - 75 cm/sec.

<u>Andhra Pradesh:</u> High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.4 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 19-11-2021 along the coast of Andhra Pradesh between Dugarajapatnam to Baruva. Current speeds vary between 75 - 175 cm/sec.
