DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1 (29.06.2022) to Day 3(01.07.2022)	Strong wind with speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar, South Tamilnadu coast and adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into above sea areas during the mentioned period.</b>

### **HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS**

**LAKSHADWEEP:** High waves in the range of 3.4 - 3.8 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours on 29-06-2021 along with Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra.  
Current speeds vary between 35 - 65 cm/sec.

### **HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS**

**KARNATAKA:** High waves in the range of 3.1 - 3.5 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 29-06-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast.
