DAY	FOR TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY COASTS
Day 1 (07.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over south Bay of Bengal and north Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the above mentioned period.
Day 2(08.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over south Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast, Comorin area and Gulf of Mannar. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.
Day 3(09.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar along & off Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.
Day 4(10.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over south Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast, Comorin area and Gulf of Mannar. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.
Day 5(11.11.2021) & Day 6(12.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over southwest Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the above mentioned period.

DAY	FOR COASTS OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY
Day 1(07.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 50-60 Kmph gusting to 70 Kmph is likely to prevail over east-central Arabian sea. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Maharashtra coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.
Day 2(08.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over east-central Arabian sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.
Day 3(09.11.2021) & Day 4(10.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over southeast Bay of Bengal, Westcentral Bay of Bengal, along & off Andhra Pradesh coast and east-central Arabian sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the above mentioned period.
Day 5(11.11.2021) & Day 6(12.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over south Andhra coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the above mentioned period.
