Day 3(08.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over south Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast, Comorin area and Gulf of Mannar. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.</b>
Day 4(09.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Comorin area, Gulf of Mannar along & off Tamilnadu coast. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.</b>
Day 5(10.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over south Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast, Comorin area and Gulf of Mannar. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.</b>
Day 6(11.11.2021) & Day 7(12.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over southwest Bay of Bengal, along & off Tamilnadu coast. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas during the above mentioned period.</b>

DAY	FOR COASTS OTHER THAN TAMIL NADU AND PUDUCHERRY
Day 1(06.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 50-60 Kmph gusting to 70 Kmph is likely to prevail over Westcentral Bay of Bengal, along & off Andhra Pradesh coast, Maharashtra coast and east-central Arabian sea. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Goa-Karnataka coast, Maharashtra coast. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.</b>
Day 2(07.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 50-60 Kmph gusting to 70 Kmph is likely to prevail over east-central Arabian sea. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over Maharashtra coast. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.</b>
Day 3(08.11.2021)	Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph is likely to prevail over east-central Arabian sea. <b>Fishermen are advised not to venture into these sea areas.</b>
