Subject: Enhanced rainfall activity over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during the next five days

Rainfall occurred at *many* places over Coastal Tamilnadu, at *a few* places over South Interior Tamilnadu and over Karaikal area during the past 24 hours ending 08:30 IST of 17.05.2024.

Isolated heavy occurred over Kanyakumari district during the same period.

Under the influence of upper air cyclonic circulations over Tamilnadu and neighbourhood, *light to moderate* rainfall at *many* places with *isolated heavy to very heavy* rain, *thunderstorm and lightning with strong winds, speeding reaching 30-40 kmph* is likely over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during the next five days (17.05.2024 to 21.05.2024) as detailed below:

Day 1 (17.05.2024)	Heavy to very heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Kanyakumari, Tirunelveli and Tenkasi districts.

	Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Nilgiris, Coimbatore, Erode, Salem, Dharmapuri, Krishnagiri, Tirupattur, Kanyakumari, Tirunelveli, Tiruppur, Virudhunagar, Thoothukudi and Madurai districts.
Day 3 (19.05.2024)	Heavy to very heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Kanyakumari, Tirunelveli, Tenkasi, Theni and Dindigul districts.
	Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Madurai, Sivaganga, Ramanathapuram, Virudhunagar, Thoothukudi, Pudukkottai, Nilgiris, Coimbatore and Tiruppur districts.
Day 4 (20.05.2024)	Heavy to very heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Kanyakumari, Tenkasi, Theni, Ghat areas of Tirunelveli, Pudukkottai and Ramanathapuram districts.
	Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Madurai, Sivaganga, Virudhunagar, Thoothukudi, Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, Mayiladuthurai, Nagapattinam, Dindigul, Cuddalore, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Tiruchirappalli, Nilgiris, Coimbatore and Tiruppur districts & Karaikal area.
Day 5 (21.05.2024)	Heavy to very heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Tenkasi, Tirunelveli and Theni districts.
	Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over Kanyakumari, Virudhunagar, Madurai, Sivaganga, Pudukkottai, Tiruvarur, Thanjavur, Mayiladuthurai, Nagapattinam, Tiruchirappalli, Perambalur, Ariyalur, Cuddalore, Kallakurichi, Villupuram, Thoothukudi, Ramanathapuram and Dindigul districts, Puducherry and Karaikal area.










