HIGH WAVE WARNING ISSUED BY INCOIS

<u>LAKSHADWEEP</u>: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.7 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours on 25-06-2021 along with Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 25 - 80 cm/sec.

HIGH WAVE ALERT ISSUED BY INCOIS

KARNATAKA: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.2 meters are predicted till 2330 hours of 25-06-2022 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast.
